Presenting issue: check all that apply	
1.	Inadequate Food, Shelter, clothing, supervision, physical or mental health care or mental health issues or health literacy
2.	Dementia/Poor cognition/Poor judgement/Delusional/Memory loss
3.	Hoarding or pets that have become a health or safety concern
4.	Homelessness or risk of homelessness
5.	Pest infestation, mice, roaches, fleas, bed bugs, etc.
6.	Utilities shut off notices, rental eviction, loss of benefit services or programs such as Elderly Waiver etc.
7.	The individual reports that they are victims of abuse
8.	<b>Self-Neglect:</b> Capacity to consent-unable to make decisions, in harm's way. Does not recognize danger, deprivation of food, shelter, clothing, lack of supervision, physical care, mental health care, or other care necessary to maintain independent living.
9.	<b>Neglect:</b> Caregiver and/or non-caregiver is unable or unwilling to continue to provide service to consumer with issues, including mental health.
10.	<b>Abuse &gt; Physical, Emotional and Verbal:</b> Caregiver and/or non-caregiver is confining, intimidating, willfully injuring, or punishing the consumer, subjecting the consumer to physical harm, pain, or isolation. Caregiver is refusing to provide goods or services that are necessary to avoid physical harm and mental anguish
11.	<b>Sexual Abuse</b> or sexual exploitation
12.	<b>Financial Exploitation:</b> (any caregiver, friend, family member, legal representative) using consumer resources for monetary or personal benefit in profit or gain
13.	<b>Personal Degradation:</b> Will act or statement by a caretaker intended to shame, degrade, humiliate, or otherwise harm the personal dignity of a dependent adult. Includes, taking, transmissions, or a display of an electronic image of a dependent adult by the caretaker, where their actions constitute a willful act or a statement intended to shame, degrade, humiliate, or otherwise harm the personal dignity of the dependent adult
